<p>This must be read in conjunction with Risk Assessment Number 1</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➔ Gloves/mittens to be worn. Legs and arms fully covered – adequate clothing for indoor snow slopes ➔ Standard operating procedures of the Snowsport England /slope provider's operating guidelines ➔ Equipment check and adjustment by a competent person ➔ All skiers to ski in control be aware of own ability ➔ Appropriate supervision of all ski-ing activity
